A Letter from our Board President and CEO...

Richland Newhope Industries, Inc. (RNI) continued to expand services and develop community integrated opportunities for people with development disabilities in Richland, Crawford, and surrounding counties during the last fiscal year. Over the last year, we supported over 600 people with developmental disabilities in employment, community integration, homemaker personal care and transportation.

Community employment has increased the number of partnerships with businesses hiring people with developmental disabilities by 33%. Within the last year there have been a cumulative placement of 82 participants.

RNI has supported people to make meaningful connections with their community through socialization and volunteering. Some of the activities enjoyed were bowling, attending the symphony, visiting A Christmas Story House, and to the Infield to go go-carting. Many people enjoyed volunteering at Pony Express, making pillows for the Galion hospital and making blankets for Project Linus. During the fiscal year 2018-2019, RNI averaged 432 hours each month people were able to be in the community. This is a 21% increase from fiscal year 2017-2018.

In the last year, RNI has been able to show off our new logo by replacing our exterior signs at our Crawford and Richland locations. In addition, we have increased our community awareness by increasing our posts on Facebook, Instagram, and our website.

Internally, we provided extensive training to our employees ensuring we have the knowledge and resources to support people in achieving their goals and dreams.

With your support we are able to continue working towards our mission and supporting people with developmental disabilities in Richland, Crawford and surrounding counties to be valued by and part of their community. We look forward to an exciting future of continued partnerships and expanded opportunities for people with developmental disabilities. Thank you for your continued support.



NEW COMMUNITY EMPLOYERS PER MONTH


