This included all locations in Richland County and Crawford Counties. RNI, Inc. also closed the Element of Art Studio/Gallery, City Garden Cafe and Trillium Event Center. RNI will continue supporting people, as needed at their community jobs, transportation or at their homes. Thank you to all employees

who have accepted their reassignments.

There will be no onsite activities at any of the RNI, Inc. locations.
